A little gory I know but I asked my surgeon to take pictures of what they removed as I wanted to show people what Crohn's and Colitis look like on the inside with it being such an invisible illness, so if you're ever at any of our meetings, and would like to see just ask, randomly I'm actually quite proud of my pictures and very proud of my "battle wounds". Initially I raised funds for the Local Network and started attending the meetings to find out more about what I could expect. From that point on I wanted to help support people and raise awareness of Inflammatory Bowel Disease; unfortunately I still believe that

the condition isn't well known and would love to change that within our area. I've been the Lead Volunteer for the Network for over 2 years, and I help coordinate the other volunteers to ensure that we can bring you the education meetings we regularly hold - and hopefully in the New Year some social events! I also look after our Social Media Channels, Facebook and Twitter, manage the emails that are received by the Network and also produce this amazing newsletter ©

I've also been the Lead Volunteer for Newcastle WALK IT for the last few years, and I'm extremely proud of what we have achieved from scratch.
